

Emergency Supply Kit

Once storm hits the area it is important to have a supply kit ready to go..

Essentials

- **Battery powered radio**
- **Flashlight**
- **Extra batteries**
- **Fire extinguisher**
- **First Aid Kit**
- **Essential medications**



Food

- **Water: at least 3 gallons per person per day for 5 days**
- **Canned food and can opener**

Personal items

- **Clothing: protective clothing, rainwear**
- **Eyeglasses**
- **Blankets or sleeping bags**
- **Toiletries**
- **Infant necessities (baby food, diapers)**
- **Special items for elderly or disabled family members**
- **Pet supplies**
- **Games and books**

Important documents

- **Checkbook, cash, credit cards**
- **Copy of prescriptions and important papers such as insurance, deeds, birth certificate, passports**
- **Instructions on how to turn off gas, water and electric, if authorities advise you to do so. Note: only professional can turn them back on**
